# Breastplate of Righteousness

- The devil is working overtime to get the Church to hold on to the ways of the world.
- There is no such thing as a weekend warrior when it comes to faith in Jesus.

# Shoes of Peace

- Paul wants us to understand that prayer as essential as communication on a battlefield is vital.
- Battles can be won or lost because of either good or bad communication.
- The devil uses silence between us and God, and us and one another to defeat us.
- The less we pray the less we experienced God's miracles, anointings and blessings.
- When we pray the Kingdom of God comes down.
- When we pray in the Spirit, God's Spirit is interactive with us.
- When we pray in the Spirit, we are being empowered and instructed by God's Spirit.
