

# There is Love in the Resurrection

- Resurrection love overflows from us to others.
- Resurrection love needs to characterize all of our conversations.
- God's Kingdom cannot sustain harsh, critical, unloving words and spirits.

# There is Life in the Resurrection

- There is life and victory because Jesus rose from the dead.
  - At the moment we respond in faith to God, we will be united with Jesus in His resurrection life.
  - God freely offers to us new life.
  - He will not force it on you; He will not shove it down your throat but offers it freely.
