Satan Was Originally An Angel

- Lucifer rebelled and was expelled from heaven and driven to earth in disgrace where he is known as Satan.

The Rebellion

- Lucifer's rebellion was an actual rebellion against truth itself!
- Because Lucifer was expelled from the source of all truth, lies became his reality!
- As God is incapable of lying, so Satan is incapable of telling the truth.
- Satan lies by nature.

Satan's Encounter With Mankind

- Satan craved the worship and adoration that belonged to God alone.

- God predestined His creation to become a glorious being who would be an heir with God's own Son.
- God's grand purpose to make us heirs with God the Son was everything of which Satan had originally dreamed.
