Pergamum was located about 37 miles north of Smyrna and 9 miles from the Aegean Sea. It was the official capital of the province of Asia Minor.

Library

Pergamum was known its huge library.

Two-Edged Sword

- In the letter to Pergamum, Jesus describes Himself as the one who has a sharp two-edged sword.
- Pergamum was the capital of Asia and the administrative home of the Roman Governor.
- The Roman Governor who had his office in Pergamum had the right of the sword.
- Jesus reminds the believers that, as the one with the sharp two-edged sword, the last word belongs to Him.

Commendation

 The city of Pergamum had three primary religious philosophies when this letter was written:

- The worship of Zeus
- The worship of Asclepios
- The worship of Caesar

 Rome did not care what god or gods you worshipped as long as you were also willing to worship Caesar.

 The church was commended for their loyalty and faithfulness even in the face of death.

Nevertheless...

- There is no evidence to suggest that sin was a major issue in the church.
- The church was just not condemning sin.
- The historical period this church represents is referred to as the compromising church, a period in history from 313AD until 600AD.
- The church was no longer comprised of those who had experienced a life changing experience.
- The church in Pergamum does not represent an apostate church but a church that is on the downward spiral to apostasy.

The Warning

- Jesus said He will fight those who are trying to destroy the church.
- When Jesus refers to the "Sword of my mouth," He is referring to the Scriptures.
- The sword of Christ is the word of Christ.
- When churches get to the point where they teeter on the brink of apostasy, God calls up someone to preach Biblical Admonition and Repentance to the church.

Conclusion

We will be victorious.

- It is not how well you start the race that counts it is how well you finish.
- If you do not like the earthly form of feeding upon Jesus, what makes you think that you will enjoy heaven?
- We will receive a New Name engraved on a white stone.
 - The important thing is not the stone, it is the new name that we are given.
