Revelation 1, 4, 21, 2 Corinthians 3

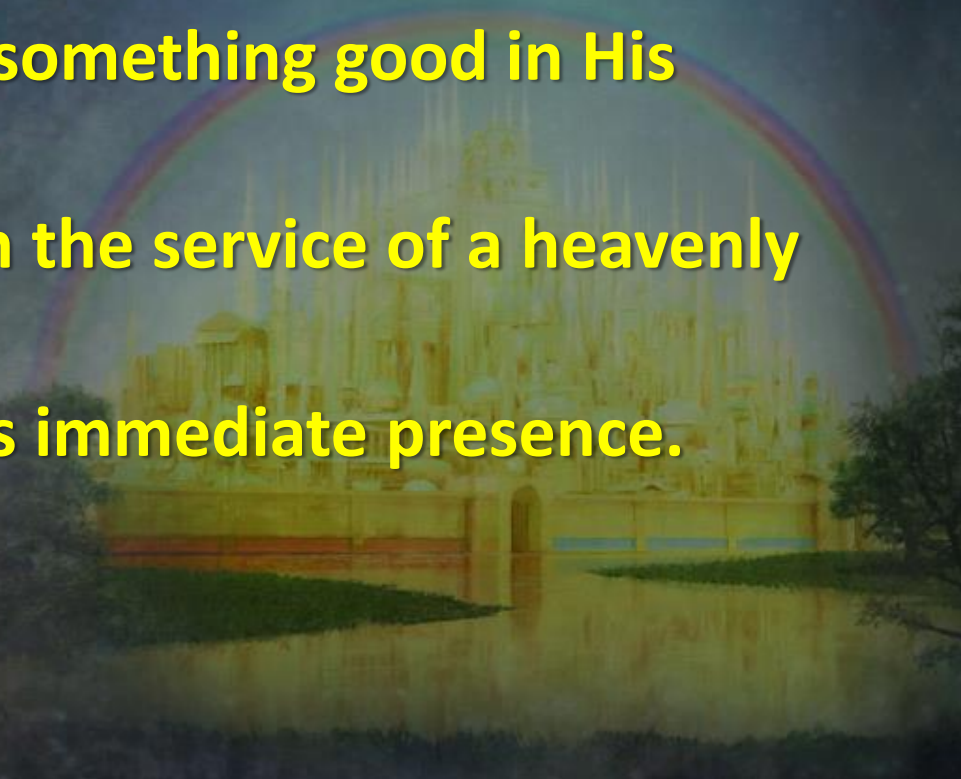
What We Will Not Do In Heaven

- We will never get sick in heaven.



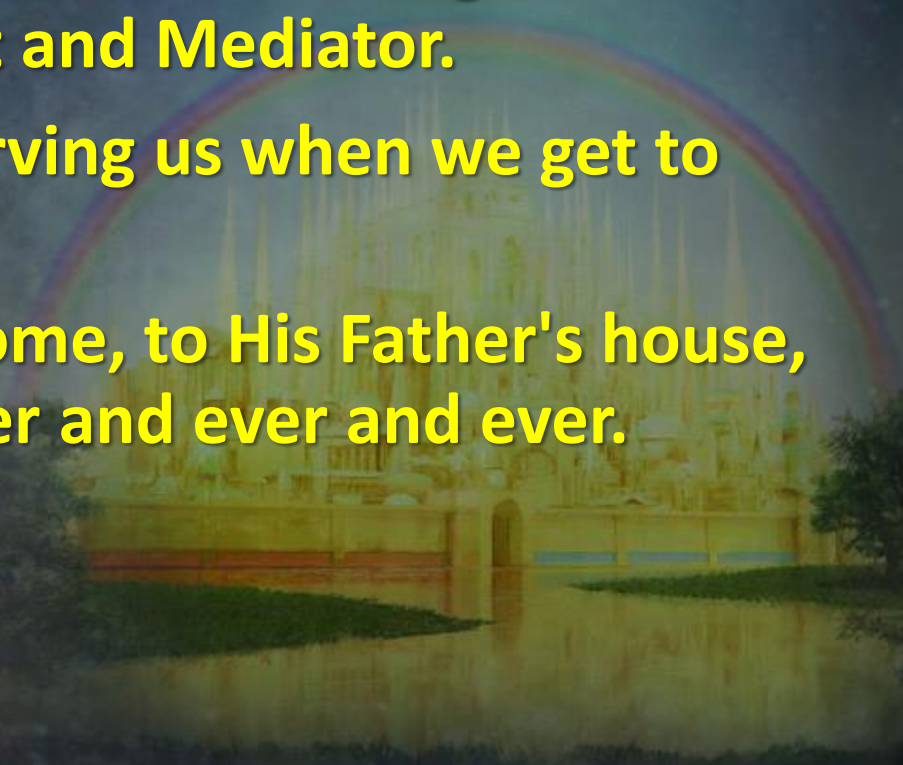
We Will Be Engaged In Service In Heaven

We Will Worship


- We will worship in heaven.
