- The religions of the world teach DO, but the central message of Christianity is DONE.
- There is not anything you can do to save yourself.

Received by Faith

- Salvation is a gift that can only be receive by faith.
- No one can boast that they got to heaven on their own merit.
- Salvation is not based on performance; it is based on God's grace.
- You get to heaven, not based on merit, but God's mercy.
- We all deserve to be banished forever from God's presence, but He invites us to join His family.

Available to Everyone

- God does not play favorites.
- The Jews were called God's chosen people because they were chosen to spread the message that there is one true God.
- Anyone who calls on the name of the Lord, who has faith in the grace of God, will be saved.
- Heaven is perfect and we are not.
- The only way we are going to get into heaven is by receiving God's gift by faith which is available to every person.

Christ Purchased

- Jesus Christ is the only way to heaven because He paid the price of admission.
- Grace is free, but it is not cheap.
- In the New Testament, the favorite description for someone who has received the grace of God is the term "in Christ."
- To dwell with a perfect God in heaven requires perfection, and none of us measure up to that standard.
- Jesus offers to do for us what we cannot do for ourselves.

Extended to Eternity

- The results of God's grace are going to go on and on forever.
- God saves the best for last, and the best is yet to come.
- Heaven is going to be:
 - A place of reunion.
 - A place of reward.
 - A place of release.
 - A place of reassignment.
