### **Keeps Me Grounded**

- When you accepted God's gift of salvation, you went from being property of the devil to being a child of God.
- The devil is looking to destroy you.
- We stand against the devil by being self-controlled and alert.
- You will never outgrow temptation.
- It is not a sin to be tempted; it is a sin to give in to temptation.
- God will never allow more temptation in your life than you can handle.
- The greatest way to handle temptation is to have an accountability partner.

# **Keeps Me Going**

- Life requires a lot of strength, a lot of energy.
- It is hard to live for Christ in a world controlled by the devil.
- We cannot live a victorious Christian life in our own strength.
- The Christian life is not a matter of willpower but a matter of God power.
- Because God's power is unlimited, He never gets tired.
- God's grace is a sustaining grace.

### **Keeps Me Growing**

- God's grace keeps us growing when we are troubled.
- There will be times in life when we face obstacles that seem unsurmountable.
- There are some things in life that are going to continue to be a burden.
- There are some situations in life that are just part of our world, and all the wishing and praying is not going to make them go away.
- God knows that we are weak.
- God gives us the grace we need for each day with the promise, 'More to follow.'
