The Resurrection

- Mighty churches anticipate the resurrection.
- Paul compares the resurrection to a seed that is buried in the ground before sprouting new life.
- When you die, your spirit moves out of your body temporarily until it has been repaired and remodeled.
- At the resurrection, your spirit will move into your newly remodeled, indestructible, glorified, powerful, supernatural body.

A Great Reunion

- A mighty church can look forward to a great reunion.
- Mighty churches not only look forward to a reunion but to our reward.
- If you put your faith in Jesus, you will not have to prove your worth to get your reward.
- Jesus promises one thing that no one else can offer—eternal life.
- Paul wanted the Thessalonian church to see the coming of Christ as an encouragement.
