Belief in God

- Belief in God, by Americans, has dipped to its lowest level since the question was first asked in a survey in 1944.
- Of those that self-identify as Democrats only 72% believe in God compared with 92% of those who identify as Republicans.
- The term “Christian” is now just a generic label.
- Today, most people who claim to know God have no clue Who He is.
- God will deal severely with those who do not acknowledge His being.

God Exists

- God's name for Himself deals with His existence.
- God's very name for Himself proclaims His existence.
- Our prosperity is quite literally killing us because we have no need for God, so why search for Him?
- Two ways God has revealed himself:
 - Natural - God has been revealed in the natural world around us.
 - Special - God has revealed Himself to us through His Word, the Holy Scriptures.
- God has revealed Himself in such a way to hold all people accountable.

Without Excuse

- God owns it all, therefore we all are answerable to Him.
- If you use the word “God” or the notion of a divine creator, it is dismissed as NOT science, but is considered superstition.
- The Scriptures say, “*they are without excuse*” and thereby subject to the wrath of God.
- A “fool” in Biblical terms means more than just a person who lacks good sense or sound judgment, it means a moral degenerate, someone who is worthless and godless.
- We cannot go to God on our own terms.
