### **Monster Of Shame**

- Adam and Eve confused a proper reaction of guilt and allowed the monster of shame to overtake them.
- Guilt is responsibility, while shame is identity based.
- We get trapped by what happened to us and allow what happened to us in the past to label us.
- Our issue becomes our identity.
- The real problem with the monster of shame is that it causes us to hide.

#### Shame Leads To Games

- Shame causes us to try and cover ourselves to make us presentable.
- Shame leads to blame.
  - Adam blamed God.
  - Adam blamed Eve.
  - Eve blamed the snake.
- We cover ourselves in criticizing everyone else and blaming everyone else.

## **Destroy Shame By Not Hiding**

- You know you are in bondage to shame when you try to cover what God already sees.
- What we are hiding becomes leverage used by the enemy to keep us distanced from God.
- Our ability to live whole, healed, and shame free lives is linked to our willingness to live unhidden and uncovered.
- Shame is destroyed when you no longer focus on actions but on relationship.
- Shame causes us to focus on our actions and forget to focus on our position.

#### Conclusion

- Shame is destroyed when we remember that God cannot remember.
- Repentance causes God to forget!
- Shame brings our sin to our mind, so we conclude that God's mind must be full of it as well.
- There are people in your life that are more comfortable with you when you are bound than when you are free!
- Jesus will go out of His way just for you.
- Jesus came all the way across the divide of eternity from heaven not just to save us, but so we could be clothed with His righteousness and His forgetfulness.
