- God will cut short those days of "great tribulation" to spare His chosen people, the Jews, from complete annihilation.
- We can escape the wrath to come, whether it's the tribulation wrath or the wrath of hell, simply by putting our faith in Jesus Christ.
- Jesus has already alerted us that a storm is coming.

Ignore Those Who Say Jesus Has Already Returned

- Everyone will see Christ's coming, so refrain from following after any secret messiahs.
- When Jesus returns, He will return as the victorious King.
- There are many leaders who claim to they can save you if you follow them.
- Be careful who you follow, especially in these days before Jesus returns.

Look For Signs In The Sky

- Anticipate celestial changes immediately preceding Christ's glorious return.
- However, Jesus comes, it will be unmistakably glorious, even as it causes the whole world to mourn.
- When the Jews see Jesus at His second coming, they will realize the mistake they made when they rejected Him as their Messiah.
- God still has a plan for His chosen people.
- When Jesus comes again, the whole world will mourn, and He will gather His chosen people, the Jews, back into their land with a loud trumpet sound.
- Jesus will come with great fanfare and glory to make all things right.
