God's Names

- In biblical times, a person's name revealed something about that person.
- In the Bible, the title "LORD" in all capital letters stands for the title "YHWH," or God, and when you see it with a capital "L" and the rest of the word in lower case, it stands for "Adonai," or Lord Master.
- All of God's different names are windows into His infinite mystery.
- It is through Jesus that we get a whole new insight into the heart and nature of God.

God's Picture

- If we want to get a picture of God, we must look in the direction of Jesus.
- Our picture of God should be constantly redrawn as our knowledge and experience of Him continues to grow and expand.
- The love that we see in Jesus is like the light that comes from the sun; it never ceases.
- If there is any doubt as to the length and depth and breadth of God's love for us, all you have to do is look at the cross.
- The cross is an immeasurably rich symbol of the ever-present power of God's love.

Conclusion

- When we are given courage to keep going, to keep living through the pain, that is a “little Easter.”
- Any time we are surprised with new possibilities for life and healing in the midst of brokenness and decay, that is a “little Easter.”
- Jesus said that our suffering is His suffering, our grief is His grief, and, in our darkness and pain, Jesus is constantly seeking to bring about another “little Easter” for us.
- Jesus died so that we would know the full extent of His offer of forgiveness.
