Receive His Investment In You

- Everything we have belongs to Jesus.

Increase His Investment In You

- Multiply the trust Jesus placed in you.
- Do not be lazy with the Lord's money, instead, like a good servant, put it to work for Him.

- Jesus wants you to take care of your family, but what other good things does He want you to do with His money?

Believe That Jesus Will Reward You

- Jesus richly rewards His faithful servants by putting them in charge of "much" and welcomes them into His Kingdom.
- At the end of the age, what will Jesus find that you have done with His money?
- People do not go to hell because they are poor.
- Financial mismanagement is only a symptom of a deeper, spiritual problem.
- You do not have to do great things with Jesus' money, just little things, to receive His reward.

- Faith is not only the key to Christ's coming Kingdom; it is the key to faithfulness here and now before Jesus comes again.
- TRUST is the key to TRUST-worthiness, because if you believe that God will reward you generously, you cannot help but serve Him faithfully.
