Be A Sheep

- Ensure that you are an heir to the riches of God's Kingdom by trusting Christ with your life.
- Only God's legitimate heirs inherit God's Kingdom
- The meek of Matthew 5:5, will INHERIT the earth.
- The meek are those in Matthew 19:29, who left everything to follow Christ.
- No matter what state you find yourself in this life, you have an eternal inheritance through faith in Christ.

Receive the Kingdom

- Jesus identifies His brothers as those who follow Him and do God's will.
- Those whose loyalty is to Christ will be unable to buy or sell anything unless they declare their allegiance to the antichrist through the "mark of the beast."
- Believers during the tribulation will have to depend on one another for survival.
- To receive the King's messengers is to receive the King Himself.
- God's heart of compassion will move your heart to have compassion for those in need.

Conclusion

- Do not let an unbelieving heart keep you out of Christ's Kingdom.
- When you reject the King's messengers, you reject the King.
- You cannot get into God's Kingdom just because you look good on the outside.
