Genesis 5:1-32, Ecclesiastes 3:11, Hebrews 11:5

## Walking with God

- After Enoch fathered Methuselah at age 65, he walked with God.
- Enoch walking with God is a significant point in this passage because it is repeated two times.
- Enoch had such a good communion with God that it gave the impression that he walked next to God.
- Enoch really wanted to know the character of God.
- After 365 years Enoch only scratched the surface.
- To study God is to develop an intimacy that ultimately results in the worship of God.

#### Faith in God

- Because Enoch developed a love of God, the natural outcome was a deeper faith in God.
- Being sure and certain for which we hope is the idea of bringing substance to something that is invisible.
- People who lived before the flood were commended for this type of faith.
- Enoch was commended as one who pleased God.
- Faith is the prerequisite to be able to please God.
- It is impossible to please God unless you have faith that He exists, and you make Him part of your life.

#### God Rewards Us

- As Enoch walked with God, God revealed more of Himself to him.
- God placed the knowledge that He exists in Enoch's heart.
- People are born, not only with original sin, but also with the knowledge of God.
- God has placed eternity in our heart.
- The difference between Enoch and everybody else who gets that seed placed into them is that Enoch acted on it.
- Enoch believed so much in God he kept seeking Him in whatever way that he could at that time.

### **Enoch's Departure**

- Only two people in the whole Bible did not experience death.
- We do not know what our death experience is going to be.
- Chariots of fire came down, swooped Elijah up, and took him to heaven in a whirlwind.
- The presence of God became so overwhelming with Enoch that at some point God said, "You might as well be in heaven."

- As we walk with God, God begins to reward us with a deeper revelation of Him.
- We must believe that God exists and live a life as though He does exist.
