Jesus Reminds the Church

- Jesus was telling His followers in Smyrna that He's been there; He's gone through the fires of life.
- The writer wants whoever is questioning to know, believe, and trust that, according to the Jewish worship system, Jesus is the great high priest.
 The writer wants everyone to know that Jesus
- The writer wants everyone to know that Jesus is the author of life; He was there at the beginning of time, and He will be there at the end of time.
- Jesus is reminding us that He has overcome, and that He has been through it all!

Problems

- The word "afflictions" is not describing ordinary troubles of life but a doomsday affliction.
- The word "afflictions" literally means totally destitute.
- Jesus tells them that even though they are dirt poor, in His eyes they are rich.
- Jesus knows our poverty and He knows our riches.
- In their poverty, the Christians at Smyrna learned that Jesus was all they really needed.

Difficulties

- Malicious lies were being told about the people in the church at Smyrna.
- The Jewish people banded together with the pagans in order to accuse the Jewish-Christians of treason against Rome.
- The Jews who attacked them were not really Jews at all; they were Jews in name only.
- Many times, religion itself gets in the way, blinding people of their need for God because they think they can contribute something toward their own salvation.
- Do not be surprised when religious people hate you; they hated Jesus.

Jesus Knows Our Troubles

- Jesus has perfect knowledge about what's going on; He knows what was, what is, and what will happen.
- If Jesus says you will suffer for ten days, no force on earth can make it last 11 days!
- Jesus never promises to remove the trials of life.
- All who call on Jesus will receive the crown of righteousness, the crown of victory!

Conclusion

- The second death is what those who do not belong to Jesus will be subject to; it is eternal damnation.
- Jesus promises that those who are faithful to Him will not experience this second death.
- When you are facing difficulties in life, rest assured, Jesus is there with you.
- Do not run from the troubles of life; embrace Jesus all the more.
